The 22nd Annual National March for Life and surrounding events are set for May 8-10, 2019, with the primary event, the pro-life rally on Parliament Hill and the March for Life throughout downtown Ottawa, taking place on May 9.

Every year, thousands of Canadians make their way to our nation's capital to march not for themselves, but for the most vulnerable and innocent members of our human family, the unborn. They march on their behalf calling upon our government and all parliamentarians to introduce legal protection for children in the womb and to create a law that will defend all human beings from the time of conception (fertilization) until natural death.

The annual Candlelight Vigil, following a church service at St. Theresa of the Child Jesus Parish, is the official start to the three-day event in Ottawa, and Campaign Life Coalition is providing an opportunity for those unable to attend the March for Life, to symbolically be part of this Candlelight vigil by pledging a candle for a minimum offer of \$5.00. The candles are carried by the participants in the vigil.

Please encourage your family and friends, co-workers and members of your faith community to pledge and join us in spirit. We urge you to make as many copies of the pledge form as you need and encourage others to pledge candles.

Your pledges also help defray the substantial costs that come with organizing and promoting this annual event.
